SHERRY SIMON-HELDT

Sherry has worked in the counseling field for 25 years in community college, agency, and university settings. Prior to opening her own practice in 2002, she was employed by the University of Arizona, College of Public Health, as a trainer-of-trainers for a statewide addiction cessation program. Sherry works with individuals, couples, and groups in process of addiction recovery, healing childhood sexual trauma, and grief. As an equine-interaction therapist for the past 13 years, Sherry has developed and presented various equine-related workshops and intensives for professionals and clients. She has been a mentor for students interested in the field of equine therapy, served as an equine therapist for a women's residential treatment facility, developed an equine therapy program at an addiction treatment program in Central America, taught a class on Equine-Interaction Psychotherapy for Pima Community College's H.E.R.D. Program, and facilitates equine therapy workshops for the Homicide Survivors organization in Tucson. She also spends time in Mexico, where she volunteers teaching English conversation classes and in any other ways she can be of service.

Sherry lives with her husband, Tim (who has been a major contributor to all the equine work over the years), their four horses and two dogs.

BETH STRAUSS

Beth began her career as a special education teacher in North Carolina and soon realized after working with children with low self-esteem and doing her own personal work, that her passion was in helping others through counseling. Beth then obtained her master's degree from the University of Arizona in 1994 and has 20+ years' post-masters experience working with diverse populations in the Tucson community in both inpatient and outpatient settings serving individuals who have co-occurring disorders, depression, anxiety, PTSD, addiction issues, grief and loss and other significant life challenges. In 2005, after being a main care giver for her beloved sister, Laura, who died from brain cancer that same year, Beth began working at Tucson Medical Center Hospice as a social worker for almost 10 years. She is a trained facilitator for externalization work based on Elisabeth Kubler-Ross's workshop model assisting those experiencing past, present and/or impending loss and has helped staff weekend-long intensive workshops in Tucson, California, and New Jersey. This process is based on the transformative power of having a safe place to tell the story, express repressed emotions, while being heard and understood with compassion. Beth currently has a private practice in Tucson working with adults and works part time as the Jewish Community
